Speech Pathologists interested in keeping up to date with the group's activities but not being an active member, can do so through the EBP Network website.

### Meetings

The NSW Aged Care EBP group will meet up to 6 times annually. The meeting dates will be set by the group leader. Meetings will be held via teleconference using Microsoft Teams as organised by the group leader. A meeting quorum of at least 50% of active members, with representation from at least 4 workplaces will be required.
